OVERVIEW

Bullying and harassment of any student or employee at a public K-12 educational institution is prohibited. Bullying is systematically and chronically inflicting physical hurt or psychological distress on one or more students.

TYPES OF BULLYING

Bullying includes:

- Teasing
- Social Exclusion
- Threat
- Intimidation
- Stalking
- Physical Violence
- Theft
- Sexual, Religious, or Racial Harassment
- Public or Private Humiliation
- Destruction of Property

Cyberbullying: Bullying through the use of technology or any electronic communication, which can include transfer of signs, signals, writing, images, sounds, data, or the creation of a website or blog that posts anything that enumerates the definition of bullying.
